





Cultural and Linguistic Diversity Scholarship

The CLD Scholarship was established to assist in meeting the need for increasing the number of culturally and linguistically diverse school psychologists. It is the intent of the Foundation to promote opportunities for the recruitment of school

second year of an accredited school psychology program in California, and must be a member of a culturally diverse minority group. They are evaluated on academic competencies, oral and written communications skills, community involvement, commitment to working in the public schools as an agent of change, and evidence of the knowledge of the demands of the vocation of school psychology.

Two CASP members – one graduate student and one newly credentialed school psychologist - are chosen to receive this prestigious award. A newly credentialed school psychologist is defined as someone who has received a credential within the last three years. The award is not renewable.

Applicants are asked to write an essay on how CASP Convention content will benefit them - either in their studies or in their practice. Graduate students must include a letter from a professor stating why the student should receive the award; the newly credentialed school psychologist must submit a similar letter from his or her supervisor. A panel of CASP members reviews the essays and applications and makes the awards.

The scholarships reimburse for an amount up to \$750 and are used for registration and workshop costs, lodging and transportation.




SALMON FACTS:

The Chinook salmon (Oncorhynchus tshawytscha), is a species of anadromous fish in the salmon family, It is a Pacific Ocean salmon and is variously known as the king salmon, tyee salmon, Columbia River salmon, black salmon, chub salmon, hook bill salmon, winter salmon, Spring Salmon and blackmouth, Chinook Salmon are typically divided into "races" with "spring chinook". "summer chinook", and "fall chinook" being most common. Races are determined by the timing of adult entry into fresh water. A "winter chinook" run is recognized in the Sacramento River.

Chinook salmon may spend between one to eight years in the ocean before returning to their home rivers to spawn, though the average is three to four years. Chinook prefer larger and deeper water to spawn in than other species of salmon and can be found on the spawning redds (nests) from September through to December. Fry and parr (young fish) usually stay in freshwater from twelve to eighteen months before travelling downstream to estuaries, where they remain as smolts for several months.

Adult fish average 33 to 36 inches, but may be up to 58 inches in length; they average 10 to 50 pounds, but may reach 130 pounds. The current sport caught World Record is 97 pounds 4 ounces and was caught in May 1985 by Les Anderson in the Kenai River (Kenai, Alaska).

Feather River Fish Hatchery

Located on the river across from historic downtown Oroville, the Feather River Fish Hatchery will feature active salmon spawning for public viewing. The Department of Water Resources (DWR) will provide guides for interpretation of this activity from 10 AM- 3 PM.

Operated by the Department of Fish and Game (DFG), the Feather River Fish Hatchery nurtures millions of Chinook salmon annually. Each spring, it releases more than 10 million salmon to the wild. The fish mature in the Pacific Ocean, with survivors migrating back up the Feather River each fall,

DWR built the fish hatchery in the 1960s to mitigate loss of upstream spawning areas for construction of Oroville Dam, key Northern California facility for California's State Water Project.

New to the hatchery venue will be a Salmon Theater where live theatrical puppet shows are scheduled to perform throughout

the day. DWR will have its fishing simulator available for visitors to enjoy. Booths and displays will provide food and educational information about salmon life cycles.



Feather River Nature Center

Across the river from the hatchery, the Feather River Nature Center will once again showcase The First Salmon Ceremony, a Maidu Tribal ritual recognizing the return of salmon to the Feather River. Throughout the day, there will be Native American dancing. hand games, displays of Maidu spear

fishing tools and dry-land demonstrations of spear fishing techniques.

The Risks and Costs of Nosocomial Infections


CDC's National Nosocomial Infectious Surveillance (NNIS) estimated the costs of nosocomial infections in 1995 at \$4.5 billion.(2)

Duke University estimated in 1997 MRSA nosocomial infections averaged \$27 million.(2)

CDC: 2000 nosocomial costs up to \$29 billion (4)

Medical College of Virginia, Richmond, Virgina, estimated the number of deaths caused by nosocomial bloodstream infections in the US

- A) Only 10% of the total of nosocomial infections would equal approximately 105,500 deaths per year.
- B) And that 5% of the total would equal 52,600

contamination was noted on 50-75%

of the sampled probes
